### c. EX Launch

- i. Rules

  - 3. Commercial motors allowed
- ii. Large turnout is expected.
- iii. Vic has received official TRA approval documentation.
- iv. A statistics report is required by TRA Complete
- v. TRA EX launch approvals are normally granted within 15 days of application.
- vi. Cut & core session needs to be scheduled. 2/28/10 11 AM @ Doug's pole barn.

#### d. Other New Business

- i. Randy has received the NAR Charter renewal documents and will forward them to Carl
- ii. Drag Race offer from Wildman KY is available for \$110. Daryl has offered to deliver to the February launch to avoid shipping charges.
- iii. Randy has nominated Vic as L3CC
- iv. Carl suggested posting FAA waiver/Insurance certificates, etc. at launches since it is individual flyer's responsibility to be aware of launch covereage. It was decided to post a notice that these documents are available upon request.
- v. Randy suggested posting a definition of "Heads-up" for spectators at launches. David suggested pre-launch safety briefings. It was determined that both are excellent ideas, but responsibility was not assigned.
