



**Indiana Rocketry, Inc.**  
**Board of Directors Meeting Minutes**  
**April 3, 2022**  
**6:00 p.m. – RTE Conference Room**



1. The meeting was called to order by President Curtis Reynolds at 6:26 p.m.
2. The following BOD members, club members and guests were present/excused/absent.  
Present: President Curtis Reynolds, Prefect Richard Cash, Secretary/Treasurer Vic Barlow, Webmaster / Social Media Randy Milliken, Member at Large Virginia McCabe, Member at Large Tim Dixon. Excused: Vice President Doug Jackson. Absent: (none). Members Attending: Erich Haley. Guests: (none).
3. The Secretary's Report was distributed via email prior to the meeting by Secretary Vic Barlow and approved as submitted. Motion was made by Richard Cash, seconded by Virginia McCabe.
4. The Treasurer's Report was distributed via email prior to the meeting by Secretary Vic Barlow. Beginning ONB balance was \$ 741.17. Ending ONB balance of \$ 741.17. Bank statement is included.
5. BOD Reports: Prior to the meeting, an informal walkthrough of the new trailer was held. Curtis indicated that painting and electrical was complete. In addition, E-Trac has been installed and the ordered cabinet has arrived and been assembled. Next steps include determining how many additional cabinets we need and how non-cabinet items will be stored.

Richard reported that the Rose-Hulman group had 3 successful Level 1 certifications and 1 successful Level 2 certification. The Purdue Orbital group had 3 successful NAR Level 1 certifications and 1 successful NAR Level 2 certifications.

Tim reported on an incident between some fliers and a farmer. We need to remind our fliers to be polite, courteous, and friendly toward our farmers and the Secretary will include landowners & farmers on all email launch announcements.

Vic reported that the old trailer license plate and registration has been found. The plate & registration were given to Curtis.

6. The following old business items were discussed.
  - a. Curtis gave an update on the status of the new trailer. Two rows of E-trac has been installed on both sides of the trailer to secure cabinets and other equipment. The ordered cabinet has been assembled and installed.
  - b. There was an extensive discussion of ThunderStruck 2023. The primary topic was range layout. We need to finalize range layout with input from farm

managers and landowners. A western layout using the access road as the centerline is preferred with parking across the road to the east.

- c. Three (3) additional cabinets will be purchased and shipped to Curtis at RTE.
  - d. Randy indicated that the club should create and post a flyer about club activities at the RC hobby shop. **ACTION NEEDED.**
7. The following new business items were discussed.
    - a. The current launch site conditions were discussed. A summer launch schedule was created.
